AND REGULATING PUBLIC NUISANCE'S WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CHURCH POINT AND REPEALING SECTION 11.34-11.42 OF THE TOWN OF CHURCH POINT'S CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE

TOWN OF THE TOWN OF CHURCH POINT, in regular session, on the <u>6th</u>, Day of <u>February</u>, 2017, that the following ordinance was introduced by <u>Councilmember Wimberley</u>, duly seconded by Councilmember Comeaux, and duly ordained and adopted .

WHEREAS, the Town of Church Point deemed it necessary and proper to submit a grant application under the State's Capital Outlay Program by the deadline of November 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislature approved Act 16 (House Bill 2), the Capital Outlay Budget in 2016 which included the Church Point Sewer System Improvements, Planning & Construction with a Capital Outlay grant amount of \$300,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town deems it necessary and proper to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the State of Louisiana for this Capital Outlay grant program; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Alderman of Town of Church Point that the Mayor of the Town of Church Point is hereby authorized to execute the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Louisiana Division of Administration, any amendments or extensions thereof, all necessary reports, studies, plans, certifications, assurances, contracts, change orders, requests for disbursement, requests for concurrence, requests for information and any other documents required in connection with this Sewer System Improvements, Planning & Construction project with a Capital Outlay grant amount of \$300,000.00 (Project No. 50-M45-16-01).
